An Act to amend the *Administrative Justice Act*, Cap. 109B.

[Commencement: 22nd August, 2019]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

**Short title**

- 1.** This Act may be cited as the *Administrative Justice (Amendment) Act, 2019*.

**Amendment of First Schedule of Cap. 109B**

**2.** *The First Schedule of the Administrative Justice Act, Cap. 109B, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended*

*(a) in paragraph (a) by deleting sub-paragraphs (ii) and (iii) and substituting the following:*

“(ii) the Administrative, General and Professional Service Commission;

(iii) the Protective Services Commission;”;

*(b) by inserting immediately after sub-paragraph (iii) the following:*

“(iii.1) the Teaching Service Commission;”.

**Amendment of Second Schedule of Cap. 109B**

**3.** *The principal Act is amended by deleting the Second Schedule and substituting the following:*

**"SECOND SCHEDULE***(Section 16(1)(b))**Person or body**Specified decision*

The Judicial and Legal Service Commission  
The Administrative, General and  
Professional Service Commission  
The Protective Services Commission  
The Teaching Service Commission



A decision against a member of the service in question in a disciplinary matter.

The Minister responsible for Town and Country Planning

A decision to approve a development plan under section 16 of the *Planning and Development Act, 2019* (Act 2019-5).

A decision given upon a review under section 33 of that Act."
