**AIRPORTS (PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES)
REGULATIONS, 1980**

1980/29.
1980/45.

Authority: These regulations were made on 25th February 1980 by the Minister under section 4 of the *Airports Act*.

Commencement: 6th March, 1980.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Airports (Parking of Motor Vehicles) Regulations, 1980*.

2. A person who

(a) parks, stops or stands a motor vehicle in an area of an airport where the parking, stopping or standing of motor vehicles is prohibited; or

(b) otherwise unlawfully parks a motor vehicle on the lands of an airport,

is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$250 or to imprisonment for 3 months or both.

3. (1) Where an authorised officer has reason to believe that an offence under regulation 2 is being or has been committed, he may give to the driver of the motor vehicle a notice referred to in these regulations as a "parking ticket", in the form set out in the *Schedule*,

Schedule.

(a) charging him with the commission of the offence;

(b) notifying him that a charge will be laid against him for the commission of the offence; and

(c) requiring him either to pay to the Airport Manager the penalty specified in the parking ticket, referred to in these regulations as the "specified penalty", within 10 days of the date of issue of the ticket or to appear before the magistrate's court to answer to the charge.

(2) For the purposes of these regulations, "authorised officer" includes a security guard employed at the airport or a member of the police force.

THE LAWS OF BARBADOS

4. Where an authorised officer finds a motor vehicle on any occasion and has reason to believe that an offence under regulation 2 is being committed, he may affix the parking ticket in a conspicuous position to the motor vehicle.

5. Notwithstanding these regulations the owner of a motor vehicle involved in the commission of an offence under these regulations is liable to be charged with the offence.

6. (1) Where the specified penalty is duly paid, no person is liable or may be convicted of the offence in respect of which the ticket was given.

(2) Payment of the specified penalty may be made personally, through an agent or by post and must be accompanied by the parking ticket.

(3) The Airport Manager must as soon as practicable after receipt of payment return to the payer the amount remitted where

- (a) the parking ticket does not accompany the payment of the specified penalty;
- (b) the amount paid or remitted is less than the amount of the specified penalty;
- (c) payment of the specified penalty reaches him after the time specified for payment.

(4) Where the amount remitted is in excess of the specified penalty, the Airport Manager must as soon as practicable after receipt of the remittance return to the payer the amount paid in excess.

7. Subject to these regulations, the Airport Manager must issue to the payer a receipt in respect of payment of the specified penalty.

8. Where the specified penalty is not paid within the time specified in the parking ticket the Airport Manager must forward to the Clerk of the Magistrates' Court, the duplicate of the parking ticket accompanied by the Airport Manager's certificate as to non-payment of the specified penalty; and the duplicate parking ticket shall be deemed to be an information laid before the Magistrate.

9. In any proceedings, a certificate by the Airport Manager of payment or non-payment of the specified penalty is sufficient evidence of the facts stated, unless the contrary is proved.

10. A person who removes or interferes with a parking ticket affixed to a motor vehicle, except under the authority of the driver of the vehicle, is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$250 or to imprisonment for 3 months or both.
