> (29th March, 2010) Commencement.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act*, 2010. Short title.

Grant of S1,835,892,283. 2. The Accountant General may, on the warrant of the Minister or a person authorised by the Minister in writing, issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted for the service of the year ending the 31st March, 2011 a sum not exceeding in the aggregate \$1,835,892,283.

Appropriation. Schedule. 3. The sum referred to in section 2 is hereby appropriated for the services and purposes set out in the *Schedule* in accordance with section 109(1) of the *Constitution* and is so appropriated as from 1st April, 2010.

Date on **4.** The date on which the grant of the sum referred to in section 2 which grant takes effect, is 1st April, 2010.
