BARBADOS CITIZENSHIP REGULATIONS, 1967

Authority: These Regulations were made on 24th August, 1967 by the Minister under section 14 of the *Barbados Citizenship Act*. L.N. 148/1967. 1993/66. 2004/152. 2005/19.

Commencement: 9th October, 1967. 1971/193. 1974/135. 1976/7. 1982/40. 1982/223.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Barbados Citizenship Regulations, 1967*. Short title.

2. For the purposes of these Regulations, "the *Constitution*" means the Constitution of Barbados. Interpretation.

PART I

Citizenship by Registration

3. (1) An application by

(a) a woman for registration as a citizen of Barbados under

(i) subsection (1) or (3) of section 3; or

(ii) section 6; or

(b) a person for registration as a citizen of Barbados under subsection (1)(b) of section 3A

(3) A certificate of registration issued by the Minister pursuant to section 5A of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form R.7 or R.8, as the case may be, in the *First Schedule*, and shall be signed by the Minister or by a person authorised by him in that behalf.

(4) A certificate of Citizenship by Descent issued by the Minister pursuant to section 2(2) or 5 of the *Constitution* shall be in the form set out as Form R.9 in the *First Schedule*, and shall be signed by the Minister or by a person authorised by him.

5. An application for a certificate of naturalisation shall be made in the form set out as Form N.1 in the *Second Schedule*.

6. A certificate of naturalisation granted by the Minister shall be in the form set out as Form N.2 in the *Second Schedule*, and shall be signed by the Minister or by a person authorised by him in that behalf.

7. (1) The oath of allegiance required by section 7 of the Act to be taken by a person to whom a certificate of naturalisation has been granted shall be endorsed on the certificate of naturalisation to which it relates.

(2) The oath of allegiance required as aforesaid shall be taken within one calendar month of the date of the certificate of naturalisation to which it relates or within such extended time as the Minister may permit, and if the oath is not taken within the said time the certificate shall have no effect; but permission shall not be deemed to have been given under this paragraph unless a statement to that effect is endorsed on the certificate and signed by a person authorised by regulation 6 to sign a certificate of naturalisation.

(3) The oath of allegiance required as aforesaid shall be registered at the office of the Minister.

8. (1) A declaration of renunciation of citizenship of Barbados made under section 7 of the *Constitution* shall be in the form set out as Form REN.1 in the *Third Schedule*.

(2) The declaration shall, subject to the provisions of the said section 7, be registered in the office of the Minister.

(3) A certificate of renunciation granted by the Minister under the Act shall be in the form set out as Form REN. 2 in the *Third Schedule*, and shall be signed by the Minister or by a person authorised by him in that behalf.

9. (1) When it is proposed to make an order under section 9 or 10 of the Act depriving a person of his citizenship of Barbados, the notice required by subsection (5) of section 9 or by subsection (2) of section 10 thereof to be given to that person may be given,

- (a) in the case where that person's whereabouts are known, by causing the notice to be delivered to him personally or by sending it to him by post;
- (b) in the case where that person's whereabouts are not known, by sending it to his last known address.

(2) Where the Minister has given notice as aforesaid and the person to whom it is given has the right, on making application therefor, to an enquiry under section 9 or 10 of the Act, the application shall be made,

- (a) if that person is in Barbados at the time when the notice is given to him, within 21 days from the giving of the notice;
- (b) in any other case, within such time, not being less than 21 days from the giving of the notice, as the Minister may determine:

Provided that the Minister may in special circumstances at any time extend the time within which the application may be made.

(3) Any notice given in accordance with the provisions of this regulation shall, in a case in which the person to whom it is given has the right, on making application therefor, to an enquiry under subsection (6) of section 9 of the Act, include a statement of the time within which such application must be made.

10. Where an order has been made depriving a person who is a citizen of Barbados by registration of the citizenship, his name shall be removed from the register of citizens of Barbados in which it is entered.

11. Where an order has been made depriving a person naturalised in Barbados of his citizenship of Barbados, the person so deprived, or any other person in possession of the relevant certificate of naturalisation, shall, if required by notice in writing given by the Minister, deliver up the said certificate to the Minister or such person, and within such time, as may be specified in the notice, and the said certificate shall thereupon be cancelled or amended.

PART IV

Supplemental

12. Where a person wishes to make an application or declaration under any of these Regulations and the form set out in the Schedule referred to in the regulation is, in the opinion of the Minister, unsuitable to the particular case, the Minister may authorise the application or declaration being made in some other form.

14. The Minister may require any application made in accordance with these Regulations, and any claim made in any such application, to be supported by such documentary or other evidence as he may from time to time determine.

15. An application or declaration made in accordance with regulation 3, 4, 5, 6, 9 or 14 of these Regulations shall not be accepted or registered, and the oath of allegiance required by sections 3 and 6 of the *Constitution* and section 7 of the Act shall be of no effect, unless it is signed in the presence of, or administered by one of, the following persons:

(a) in Barbados,

any Justice of the Peace or notary public or any person authorised to administer oaths;

(b) elsewhere,

any consular officer of the Government of Barbados or any consular officer of Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom acting on behalf of the Government of Barbados or, if there is no such consular officer, any person authorised by the Government of Barbados in that behalf, or any person for the time being authorised by law, in the place where the applicant, declarant or deponent is, to administer an oath for any judicial or other legal purpose:

Provided that, if the applicant, declarant or deponent is serving in the armed forces, the application or declaration may be signed in the presence of, or the oath administered by, any officer holding a commission in those forces, whether the application, declaration or oath is made or taken in Barbados or elsewhere.

16. A document may be certified to be a true copy of a document for the purposes of subsection (2) of section 13 of the Act by means of a statement in writing to that effect signed by a person authorised by the Minister in that behalf.

17. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the fees specified in the *Fifth Schedule* shall in Barbados be paid in respect of the matters specified therein, and shall be applied in the manner set out in that Schedule.

(2) Where a husband and wife apply at the same time for certificates of naturalisation and are residing together at the time of the applications and the fee specified in the *Fifth Schedule* is paid in respect of the grant of a certificate to one of them, no further fee shall be payable in respect of the grant of a certificate to the other.

18. (1) For the purposes of these Regulations, there shall be established and maintained in the office of the Minister registers to be kept by the Permanent Secretary; and all matters required by the *Constitution*, the Act or these Regulations to be registered shall be entered in the appropriate register.

(2) The Permanent Secretary shall cause to be prepared a copy of all entries made during each month in each register maintained pursuant to paragraph (1); and every such copy, when certified by the Permanent Secretary to be true and correct, shall not later than 30 days after the end of the month to which it relates be transmitted to the Registrar, who shall cause the same to be registered in appropriate registers to be maintained for the purpose in the Registration Office.
