**BARBADOS PORT AUTHORITY (WATER-  
SPORTS) ORDER, 1990**

1990/43.

**Authority:** This order was made on 25th April, 1990 by the Barbados Port Authority and approved by the Minister under section 66A of the *Barbados Port Authority Act*.

**Commencement:** 3rd May, 1990.

1. This Order may be cited as the *Barbados Port Authority (Watersports) Order, 1990*.

2. For the purposes of section 66A of the Act the areas within the harbours of Barbados at the places specified in the *Schedule* are the areas in which watersports activities may be undertaken,

- (a) in the case of speedboats engaged in waterskiing, the area lying between 75 metres and 200 metres from the shore, parallel to the shore; and
- (b) in the case of any other watersports activity, the area beyond 200 metres from the shore, parallel to the shore.

3. The areas referred to in paragraph 2 shall be clearly marked by buoys.
