An Act to amend the Constitution, Cap. 1966/1455 of Barbados to revise

- (a) the qualifications for membership of the Senate; and
- (b) the provisions relating to disqualification for membership of the Senate and the Assembly.

[Commencement: 13th June, 2018]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados in accordance with the provisions of section 49 of the *Constitution* as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Amendment) Act, 2018.*

Amendment of section 37 of the Constitution

2. The Constitution, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by deleting section 37 and substituting the following:

"Qualification for membership of Senate

37. Subject to the provisions of section 38, any person who at the date of his appointment is a citizen of Barbados of the age of twenty-one years or upwards shall be qualified to be appointed as a Senator.".

Amendment of section 38 of the Constitution

3. Section 38 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by deleting paragraph (b).

Amendment of section 44 of the Constitution

4. Section 44 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by deleting paragraph (a).
