An Act to amend the *Constitution*, Cap. 1966/1455 of Barbados to revise

- (a) the qualifications for membership of the Senate; and
- (b) the provisions relating to disqualification for membership of the Senate and the Assembly.

[Commencement: 13th June, 2018]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados in accordance with the provisions of section 49 of the *Constitution* as follows:

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Amendment) Act, 2018*.

**Amendment of section 37 of the *Constitution***

2. *The Constitution, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by deleting section 37 and substituting the following:*

**“Qualification for membership of Senate**

37. Subject to the provisions of section 38, any person who at the date of his appointment is a citizen of Barbados of the age of twenty-one years or upwards shall be qualified to be appointed as a Senator.”.

**Amendment of section 38 of the *Constitution***

3. *Section 38 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by deleting paragraph (b).*

**Amendment of section 44 of the *Constitution***

4. *Section 44 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by deleting paragraph (a).*
