ELECTORAL AND BOUNDARIES COMMISSION (REVIEW OF BOUNDARIES) ORDER, 2002

2002/79.

Authority: This Order was made on 10th July, 2002 by the Governor-General under

section 41D(1) of the Constitution.

Commencement: 25th April, 2003.

WHEREAS

- (a) the Electoral and Boundaries Commission in accordance with section 41D(1) of the *Constitution* reviewed the number and boundaries of the constituencies into which Barbados is divided and on the 28th day of March, 2002 submitted a report to the Minister showing the constituencies into which it recommended that Barbados should be divided in order to give effect to the rules set out in the *Third Schedule* to the *Constitution*;
- (b) the House of Assembly on the 31st day of May, 2002, and the Senate on the 5th day of June, 2002, approved a draft of the following Order designed to give effect to the recommendation contained in the report;
- (c) it is expedient to give legal effect to that recommendation:

NOW THEREFORE the Governor-General, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 41D(5) of the *Constitution*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Electoral and Boundaries Commission (Review of Boundaries) Order, 2002.*

Constituency of Christ Church East

From a point on the sea coast south of the terminus of the School Hill-St. Christopher Road in a straight line to the terminus of the School Hill-St. Christopher Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the School Hill-St. Christopher Road to its junction with Sayes Court-Hopewell Road; thence along the middle of Sayes Court-Hopewell Road to its junction with Highway U (the Hopewell-Chancery Lane Road); thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway U to its junction with Waverley Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Waverley Road to its junction with Pegwell Boggs Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Pegwell Boggs Road to its junction with Pegwell Boggs New Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Pegwell Boggs New Road to its junction with Gibbons Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Gibbons Road to its junction with Highway 7 (the Oistins-Airport Road); thence in a north easterly direction along Highway 7 to its junction with Highway S (the Providence-Balls Road); thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Highway S to its junction with the ABC Highway; thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of the ABC Highway to its junction with Highway 6 at the Henry Forde Roundabout; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Highway 6 (the Balls-St. Patricks Road) to its junction with Highway Q (the Balls-Lower Greys Road); thence in a north easterly direction along the middle of Highway Q to its junction with Highway R (the Pilgrim-Ridge Road); thence in a southerly direction along the middle of Highway R to its junction with the ABC Highway; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the ABC Highway to a point near light pole #499; thence in a southerly direction with a straight line to its junction with the Fairy Valley Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Fairy Valley Road to its junction with the Seawell House-Paragon Road; thence along the middle of the Seawell House-Paragon Road to a straight line leading to a point on the Sea Coast south of Paragon House; thence in a westerly direction along the sea coast to a point on the coast south of the terminus of the School Hill-St. Christopher Road (the starting point).

Constituency of Christ Church East Central

From the junction of the ABC Highway with Highway R (the Upton-Kent Road) along the middle of the ABC Highway in a southerly then easterly direction to its junction with highway 6; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Highway 6 to its junction with the Bannatyne-Kingsland Road; thence in a southerly

direction along the middle of the Bannatyne-Kingsland Road to the Kingsland-Gall Hill Road; thence in a south-easterly direction along the middle of the Kingsland-Gall Hill Road to its junction with Water Street; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Water Street to its junction with Highway T (the Lodge Road-Oistins Hill Road); thence in a southerly direction along the middle of Highway T to its junction with Church Hill Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Church Hill Road to its junction with Windy Ridge Road; thence in a south easterly direction along the middle of Windy Ridge Road to its junction with Highway 7 (the Airport-Oistins Road) at Thornbury Hill; thence in a north-easterly direction along the middle of Highway 7 to its junction with Highway S (the Providence-Balls Road); thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Highway S to its junction with the ABC Highway; thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of the ABC Highway to its junction with Highway 6 (the Balls-St. Patricks Road) at the Henry Forde Roundabout; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Highway 6 (the Balls-St. Patricks Road) to its junction with Highway Q (the Balls-Lower Greys Road); thence in a north easterly direction along the middle of Highway Q to its junction with Highway R (the Pilgrim Place-St. Davids Road); thence along the middle of Highway R to its junction with an unclassified road west of Edeys Village leading to Small Ridge and Bannatyne Gardens; thence in a southerly, easterly then southerly direction along the middle of the said unclassified road to where it meets the Bannatyne Gardens Road; thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of the Bannatyne Gardens Road to its junction with Highway V (the Bannatyne-St. Davids Road); thence in a north-westerly direction along the middle of Highway V to its junction with Highway R; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway R to its junction with the ABC Highway (the starting point).

Constituency of Christ Church South

From a point on the sea coast south of the terminus of the School Hill-St. Christopher Road in a straight line to the terminus of the School Hill-St. Christopher Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the School Hill-St. Christopher Road to its junction with the Sayes Court-Hopewell Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Sayes Court-Hopewell Road to its junction at the roundabout with Highway U (the Hopewell-Chancery Lane Road); thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway U to its junction with Waverley Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Waverley Road to its junction with Pegwell Boggs Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Pegwell Boggs New Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Pegwell Boggs New Road to its junction with Gibbons Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Gibbons Road to its junction with Highway 7 (the Oistins-Airport Road); thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of Highway 7 to its junction with Church Hill Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Church Hill Road to its junction at the top

of Oistins Hill with Cane Vale Road-Maxwell Hill; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Cane Vale-Maxwell Hill to its junction with the Maxwell Hill-Graeme Hall Terrace Road; thence in a north westerly direction along the middle of the Maxwell Hill-Graeme Hall Terrace Road to its junction with the Errol Barrow Highway opposite the Ministry of Agriculture Building; thence in a northerly and then westerly direction along the middle of the Errol Barrow Highway to the eastern boundary of the Rendezvous Ridge development; thence in a southerly direction along that boundary to the base of the Rendezvous Ridge; thence in a westerly direction along the base of the Rendezvous Ridge to its junction with the Rendezvous Hill Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Rendezvous Hill Road to its junction with Highway 7; thence in a straight line to a point on the southern sea coast south of the junction of the Rendezvous Hill Road with Highway 7; thence in an easterly direction along the sea coast to a point on the coast south of the terminus of the School Hill-St. Christopher Road (the starting point).

Constituency of Christ Church West

From a point on the southern sea coast south of the junction of the Highway 7 (Hastings-Top Rock Road) with Rendezvous Hill in a straight line to Highway 7; thence in a northerly direction along Rendezvous Hill to its junction with Rendezvous Ridge, then in an easterly direction to the eastern boundary of Rendezvous Ridge Development, then in a northerly direction to the ABC Highway, thence across the ABC Highway to a point south of the western boundary of Tino Terrace (at Lot #29); thence in a northerly direction along the western boundary of Tino Terrace and Warners Gardens (Lot #53); thence in an easterly direction along Warners Gardens northern boundary to a point where it meets the southern terminus of Brownes Road (at Lot #76) thence in a northerly direction along the Brownes Road-Sargeants Village Tenantry Road to the junction with Highway 6 (the Sargeants Village Road); thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Sargeants Village Road to its junction with the Errol Barrow Highway at the Garfield Sobers Roundabout; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Errol Barrow Highway to its junction with Highway 6 (Collymore Rock-Sargeants Village Road); thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway 6 to its junction with Clapham Park Road thence along the middle of the Clapham Park Road to its junction with Clapham Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Clapham Road to its junction with Observatory Road; thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of Observatory Road to its junction with Fordes Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Fordes Road to its junction with Brittons New Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Brittons New Road to its junction with Reservoir Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of Reservoir Road to the Ridge and using an imaginary line continue over

and beyond the Ridge to the 1st Ave Dayrell's Road; thence southerly along the middle of 1st Avenue Dayrells Road to its junction with Dayrells Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Dayrells Road to its junction with the Garrison Road; thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of the Garrison Road to its junction with Highway 7; then directly across Highway 7 and continuing in a south westerly direction along the road leading to Gravesend Beach and directly to the sea; thence in an easterly direction along the sea coast to a point on the coast south of the junction of Rendezvous Hill with Highway 7 (the starting point).

Constituency of Christ Church West Central

From the junction of Sargeants Village Tenantry Road with Highway 6 (Bridgetown-Sargeants Village Road) in an easterly direction along the middle of Highway 6; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of Highway 6 to its junction with Vauxhall Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Vauxhall Road to its junction with the Bannatyne-Kingsland Road junction; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Bannatyne-Kingsland Road to its junction with the ABC highway; thence across the ABC Highway, thence in a south easterly direction along the middle of the Kingsland-Gall Hill Road to its junction with the Water Street Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Water Street Road to its junction with Highway T (the Lodge Road-Oistins Hill Road); thence in a southerly direction along the middle of Highway T to its junction with the Church Hill Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Church Hill Road to its junction with Windy Ridge; thence in a south easterly direction along the middle of Windy Ridge to its junction with Highway 7 (the Oistins-Airport Road); thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway 7 to the junction of Church Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Church Road, to its junction at Oistins Hill with the Cane Vale-Maxwell Hill Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Cane Vale-Maxwell Hill Road to its junction with the Graeme Hall Terrace-Maxwell Hill Road; thence in a north westerly direction along the middle of the Graeme Hall Terrace Road to its junction with the Errol Barrow Highway (opposite the Ministry of Agriculture); thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the Errol Barrow Highway to its junction with the Errol Barrow Roundabout; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the ABC Highway to a point south of the western boundary of Lot #29 Tino Terrace, Graeme Heights; thence in a northerly direction along the western boundary of Tino Terrace-Warners Gardens Development; thence to the northern boundary of Lot #53 Warners Gardens; thence in an easterly direction along the northern boundary of Warners Gardens to a point where it meets the southern terminus of Brownes Road (at Lot #76 Warners Gardens) thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Brownes Road-Sargeants Village Tenantry Road to its junction with Highway 6 (the starting point).

Constituency of the City of Bridgetown

From a point on the western sea coast west of the junction of Highway 7 (the Bridgetown-Oistins Road) with Beckles Road, along a straight line to the junction of Highway 7 with Beckles Road; thence along the middle of Beckles Road to its junction with Old Quarry Avenue; thence along the middle of Old Quarry Avenue to its junction with Bayview Avenue; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Bayview Avenue to its junction with Watermill Place; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Watermill Place to its junction with St. Paul's Avenue; thence in a straight line to the Culloden Farm-Roseneath southern boundary wall; thence in an easterly direction along Culloden Farm-Roseneath boundary wall to its junction with Culloden Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Culloden Road to its junction with Highway 6 (the Bridgetown-Collymore Rock Road); thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway 6 to its junction with Martindales Road; thence along the middle of Martindales Road to its junction with Halls Road at the Mencea Cox Roundabout; thence along the middle of Halls Road to its junction with Tweedside Road and Roebuck Street at the James A. Tudor Roundabout; thence in westerly direction along the middle of Roebuck Street to its junction with Country Road; thence along the middle of Country Road to its junction with White Park Road and Passage Road; thence along the middle of Passage Road to its junction with Baxters Road and Westbury Road; thence in a north westerly direction along the middle of Westbury Road to its junction with President Kennedy Drive; thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of President Kennedy Drive to its junction with Prescod Boulevard and University Row at Elsie Payne Roundabout; thence in a northerly direction, then in a westerly, and southerly direction and then in a south easterly direction along the sea coast to a point on the coast west of the junction of Highway 7 with Beckles Road (the starting point).

Constituency of St. Andrew

From a point on the eastern sea coast south of Barclays Park and east of the terminus of the gully leading to the culvert which crosses the East Coast Road, in a straight line to the terminus of the gully; thence along this gully to its junction with an unclassified road leading to Cambridge; thence in a southerly and then in a south westerly direction along this unclassified road to its junction with a public road known as Coggins Hill; thence in a north westerly direction along the middle of Coggins Hill to its junction with Highway 2 (the Haggatts-Springvale Road); thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of Highway 2 to a point in the centre of the road opposite to a monument (B.7) placed on the western side of the road; thence in a straight line to the triangulation station known as "Hillaby" S.15 at the end of the Hillaby Tenantry Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Hillaby Tenantry Road to its junction with the Farmers-Turners Hall Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of Farmers-Turners Hall Road to its junction with the Farmers-Plum Tree-Ridgeway Gully; thence in a westerly direction along the

Constituency of St. George North

From the junction of Highway 4 (Bridgetown-Bulkeley Road) with Buttals-St. George's Church Road at Turnpike, in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway 4 to its junction with Neils-Lower Estate Private Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the Neils-Lower Estate Road to its junction with the Charles Row Bridge-Lower Estate Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Charles Rowe Bridge-Lower Estate Road to its junction with the Lower Estate-Belle Road; thence in a northerly direction along the Belle Road to its junction with Highway 3; thence in a north easterly direction along the middle of Highway 3 to its junction with Cole Road at Bourne's Village; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Cole Road to the culvert where it crosses a gully; thence along this gully in a south westerly, north westerly and north easterly direction to a point opposite Applewhaites Tenantry Road; thence along the line

joining this point to the road junction and in a north westerly direction along the Applewhaites Tenantry Road to is junction with Highway E (the Hothersal Turning-Bibbys Lane Road); thence in a north easterly direction along the middle of Highway E to its junction with the Bibbys Lane-Applewhaites-Selman-Fisherpond Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Bibbys Lane-Applewhaites-Selman-Fisherpond Road to its junction with the Fisherpond-Groves Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Fisherpond-Groves Road to its junction with the Groves-Parris Hill Road; thence in a north easterly direction along the middle of the Groves-Parris Hill Road to its junction with the Andrews Factory-Redland Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Andrews-Factory-Redland Road to its junction with the Redland-Uplands Road; thence in a south easterly and then southerly direction along the middle of the Redland-Uplands Road to its junction with Highway 3B (the Golden Ridge-Pool Road); thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Highway 3B to its junction with the road leading to Belle Farm; thence in a southerly and then easterly direction along the entrance to Belle Farm to its junction with the Ellesmere-Todds Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Ellesmere-Todds Road to its junction with the Ellesmere-St. Judes Road-Newbury Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Ellesmere-St. Judes Road to its junction with Highway X; thence in a southerly direction along Highway X to its junction with the Workmans-Retreat Road; thence along the middle of the Workmans-Retreat Road to its junction with the Free Hill-Jordans Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Free Hill-Jordans Road to its junction with the St. George's Church-Buttals Road; thence in a south easterly direction along the middle of the St. George's Church-Buttals Road to its junction with Highway 4 at the Turnpike (the starting point).

Constituency of St. George South

From the junction of Highway 4 (the Bridgetown-Bulkeley Road) with Buttals-St. George's Church Road at Turnpike in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway 4 to the Roundabout on the Constant-Dash Valley Road; thence in a southerly, westerly, and then southerly direction along the middle of the Dash Valley Road to its junction with Highway 5 (the Bridgetown-Windsor Road) at Hanson Hill; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Highway 5 to its junction with the Egerton-St. Davids Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Egerton-St. Davids Road to its junction with the St. Davids-Ridge Road; thence in a westerly direction along the St. Davids-Ridge Road to its junction with Highway V (the St. Davids-Bannatyne Road) thence in an easterly direction to its junction with the Bannatyne-Small Ridge Plantation Road; thence in a northerly, westerly, then northerly direction along the middle of the plantation road to its junction with the St. Davids-Edeys-Ridge Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the St. Davids-Edeys-Ridge Road to its junction with the Ridge-Lower Greys Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the Ridge-Lower Greys Road to its junction with Highway 5 (Windsor-Bridgetown Road); thence in

an easterly direction along the middle of the Windsor-Bridgetown Road to its junction with the Edgecumbe-Ebenezer Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the Edgecumbe-Ebenezer Road to its junction with a pathway leading from Edgecumbe to Highway 4B (the Frenches-Chapel Road); thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Highway 4B to the point which it crosses the gully running to Woodland; thence in a north westerly direction along the gully to a point which is marked by a monument (B.12); thence continuing in a north westerly direction along the gully to the centre of the culvert on Highway 4 (the Woodland-Kendal Road); thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway 4 to its junction with the Woodland-Four Roads Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the Woodland-Four Roads Road to its junction with the Todds-Ellesmere Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Todds-Ellesmere Road to its junction with the Ellesmere-St. Judes-Newbury Road; thence along the middle of the St. Judes-Newbury Road to its junction with Highway X; thence in a southerly direction along Highway X to its junction with the Workmans-Retreat Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Workmans-Retreat Road to its junction with the Jordans-Free Hill Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Jordans-Free Hill Road to its junction with the St. George's Church-Buttals Road; thence in a south easterly direction along the middle of the St. George's Church-Buttals Road to its junction with Highway 4 at the Turnpike (the starting point).

Constituency of St. James North

From the outlet of the Scantlebury River on the western sea coast and along the Speightstown southern and then eastern boundary to the point crossed by Farm Road; thence in a northerly direction along the Speightstown eastern boundary to its junction with Highway 1 at Oban; thence along the Ashton Hall Road to its junction with the Ronald Mapp Highway; thence along the middle of the Ronald Mapp Highway in a southerly direction to its junction with the public road leading to Black Bess and Rock Hall; then in a generally south easterly direction along this road to the junction with the unclassified road leading to Black Bess and Mangrove Plantations; thence in a south easterly direction along this road to the point where it forks; thence in an easterly direction (passing the south of Mangrove Plantation) to the end of the road and then continuing in an easterly direction along the plantation track to the point in the centre of the track opposite the monument (B.4) placed on the southern side of the track; thence in a southerly direction in a straight line joining this point to the centre of the old mill wall at Springhead; thence in a southerly direction in a straight line to a point in the Springhead-Westmoreland Gully, 325 metres south of Springhead Plantation; thence in a westerly direction along the Springhead-Westmoreland Gully to the point at which it is crossed by the Ronald Mapp Highway; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Ronald Mapp Highway to its junction with Highway C (the Apes Hill-Trents Road); thence in a

westerly direction along the Highway C to its junction with Highway 1 (the Bridgetown-Speightstown Road); thence in a westerly direction to a point on the sea coast; thence in a northerly direction along the seacoast to the outlet of the Scantlebury River (the starting point).

Constituency of St. James South

From a point where the Prospect-Appleby-Derricks Ridge touches the University Drive, Cave Hill; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the University Drive to its junction with the Cave Hill-Hinds Hill-Husbands Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the Husbands Road to its junction with the Husbands-Clermont Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Husbands-Clermont Road to its junction with the Ronald Mapp Highway; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the Ronald Mapp Highway to its junction with the Redmans Village-Prior Park Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Prior Park Road to the Prior Park Roundabout; thence in a southerly and then south westerly direction along the middle of the Prior Park Road to its junction with the Prior Park Gardens Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Prior Park Gardens Road to a track on the southern side of Lot #18 to its junction with Denny's Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Denny's Road to its junction with Thorpes Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Thorpes Road to its junction with the Holders Hill Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Holders Hill Road to a point at the base of the Derrick-Appleby Ridge; thence in a southerly direction along the Derrick-Appleby-Prospect Ridge to the point where it touches the University Drive, Cave Hill (the starting point).

Constituency of St. James Central

From a point on the western seacoast west of the terminus of the Batts Rock Road in a straight line to Batts Rock Road; thence along the middle of Batts Rock Road to its junction with Highway 1 (the Bridgetown-Holetown Road); thence in an easterly direction to the base of the Prospect-Appleby-Derricks Hill; thence in a northerly direction along the base of the Prospect-Appleby-Derricks Hill to a point at which it is crossed by Holders Hill Road-Thorpes Road; thence in an easterly and then southerly direction along the Holders Hill Road-Thorpes Road to its junction with Denny Road; thence along the middle of Denny Road to and through the southern side of Lot #18 Prior Park Gardens; thence in an easterly direction along the Prior Park Gardens Road to its junction with Prior Park Road; thence in a northerly direction to its junction with Prior Park Roundabout; thence in an easterly direction to its junction with the Ronald Mapp Highway (the Warrens-Bennetts Road); thence in a southerly direction along the Ronald Mapp Highway to its junction with the Terrace Drive Road, Welches Terrace; thence in an easterly direction along the

Military Road to its junction with Highway 2 (Bank Hall Main Road); thence in a north easterly direction along the middle of Highway 2 to its junction with Waterford Cross Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Waterford Cross Road to its junction with Highway 3 (the Hindsbury-Waterford Road); thence in a straight line drawn in the direction of the junction of Highway 4 (the Bridgetown-Bulkeley Road) with the Belle Road to the point at which that straight line is crossed by the watercourse running between the Belle Pumping Station in a south easterly direction between Flint Hall and Licorish Village to a point east of Welches Service Station on Highway 4; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway 4 to its junction with Bridge Road; thence along the middle of Bridge Road to its junction with Bank Hall Cross Road; thence in a north westerly to westerly direction along the middle of Bank Hall Cross Road to its junction with Eagle Hall and Tudor Bridge (the starting point).

Constituency of St. Peter

From the outlet of the Scantlebury River on the western sea coast and along the Speightstown southern and then eastern boundary to the point crossed by Farm Road; thence in a northerly direction along the Speightstown eastern boundary to its junction with Highway 1 at Oban; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of Highway 1 (the Ashton Hall Road) to its junction with the Ronald Mapp Highway (the Bakers-Mile-and-a-Quarter Road); thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Ronald Mapp Highway to its junction with the public road leading to Black Bess and Rock Hall; then in a generally south easterly direction along this road to the junction with the unclassified road leading to Black Bess and Mangrove Plantations; thence in a south easterly direction along this road to the point where it forks; thence in an easterly direction (passing to the south of Mangrove Plantation) to the end of the road and then continuing in an easterly direction along the plantation track to the point in the centre of the track opposite a monument (B. 4) placed on the southern side of the track; then continuing in an easterly direction to its junction with a public road leading from Rock Hall Plantation to Rock Hall Village and a track leading to Roebuck Village; thence along this track in a generally northerly direction to its junction at Roebuck with Indian Ground-Four Hill Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Indian Ground-Four Hill Road to its junction with the public road leading from Orange Hill Plantation to Welch Town Plantation; thence continuing in a northerly direction along the Orange Hill Plantation-Welch Town Plantation Road; thence in a northerly direction along the Farley Hill-Portland Road to its junction with Mile-and-a-Quarter-Diamond Corner Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Mile-and-a-Quarter-Diamond Corner Road to its junction with the Diamond Corner-Cherry Tree Hill-Morgan Lewis Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Diamond Corner-Cherry Tree Hill-Morgan Lewis Road to its junction with a public road leading to Boscobel; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of a

public road leading to Boscobel to its junction with a private road leading to Foster's Funland; thence generally easterly along this road and along the southern section of the loop at the end; thence continuing in an easterly direction to the sea coast; thence in a northerly direction along the sea coast to a point on the coast road north of Pico Teneriffe and east of the point at which the public road leading to Boscobel begins to turn in a south easterly direction, in a straight line to this point; thence in a westerly direction along this public road from Boscobel to its junction with the Grave Yard-Lamberts Road; thence continuing in a westerly direction along the Grave Yard-Lamberts Road to its junction with the Lamberts-Alexandra-Luke Hill Road; thence in a northerly, then westerly and south westerly direction along the middle of the Lamberts-Alexandra-Luke Hill Road to its junction with Charles Duncan O'neale Highway and the private road leading to Alleynedale Hall; thence in a westerly direction and diverting along the branch of this private road so as to leave the plantation building in St. Peter and then in a northerly direction to its junction with Highway 1C (the Colleton-St. Lucy's Church Road); thence in a south westerly direction along the middle of Highway 1C to its junction with a public road leading to Shermans to Half Moon Fort; thence in a straight line to a point on the coast west of the junction of Highway 1C and the public road leading from Shermans to Half Moon Fort; thence in a southerly direction along the sea coast to a point at which the Scantlebury River touches the coast (the starting point).

Constituency of St. Philip North

From Shark's Hole on the south eastern sea coast along a straight line to the junction of the Belair-Sam Lord's Road with the Long Bay Road; thence along the middle of the Long Bay Road to its junction at Robinson's Corner with the Merricks-Eastbourne Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Merricks-Eastbourne Road to its junction with Highway M (the Bushy Park-Beulah Road); thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Highway M to its junction with the Bushy Park-Harrow Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Bushy Park-Harrow Road to its junction with the Marchfield-St. Philip's Church Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the Marchfield-St. Philip's Church Road to its junction with Church Village-Thicket Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Church Village-Thicket Road to its junction with Cox Hill; thence along the middle of the Cox Hill to a track which leads to the District C-Massiah Street Road at Moncrieffe; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of this track to the District C-Massiah Street Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of the District C-Massiah Street Road to its junction with a public road leading to Mount Pleasant Plantation; thence in an easterly and then a northerly direction along this public road to its junction with the Stewart Hill Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Stewart Hill Road to its junction with the Thicket-Palmer's Road; thence along the middle of the Thicket-Palmer's Road in a northerly direction to its junction with the College Savannah-Supers Road; thence along the middle of the College Savannah-Supers

Road to a monument (B.15) located at the St. Mark's Church driveway; thence in a straight line to a monument (B.16) near the edge of the cliff on the sea coast; thence in a southerly direction and then in a south westerly direction along the sea coast to Shark's Hole (the starting point).

Constituency of St. Philip South

From Shark's Hole on the south eastern sea coast in a straight line to the junction of Belair-Sam Lords Road with Long Bay Road; thence along the middle of Long Bay Road to its junction at the Robinsons Corner with Merricks-Eastbourne Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Merricks-Eastbourne Road to its junction with the Six Roads Roundabout and Highway 5B (the Six Cross Road-Kirtons Road); thence in a southerly direction along the middle of Highway 5B to the junction with the Four Roads-Oldbury Road; thence along the middle of the Four Roads-Oldbury Road to its junction with the Mangrove-Oldbury Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Mangrove-Kirtons Road and thence to its junction with the Kirtons-Spencers Road; thence in a south westerly, and westerly direction along the middle of the Kirtons-Spencers Road to its junction with Highway 7 (the Rock Hall-Spencers Road); thence along the middle of Highway 7 in a westerly direction to its junction with a track to the west of the Rock Hall Village; thence in a south easterly, easterly and southerly direction along this track to a point on the cliff edge to the east of the airport boundary fence (Monument B.17); thence in a southerly direction to the sea; thence in an easterly direction along the sea coast to Shark's Hole (the starting point).

Constituency of St. Philip West

From a point on the coast south of Monument (B.17) placed at the edge of the cliff and east of the Airport boundary fence; thence in a northerly direction to Monument (B.17); thence in a northerly, westerly and northerly direction along a track leading to Highway 7 (the Rock Hall-Spencers Road), thence in a easterly direction along Highway 7 to its junction with Highway 5B (the Six Roads-Kirtons Road); thence along Highway 5B to its junction with Kirtons-Mangrove Road; thence in a westerly direction along Mangrove Road to its junction with Highway N (the Oldbury Road); thence in a north easterly direction to its junction with Highway 5B (the Six Roads-Four Roads-Kirtons Road); thence in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Six Cross Roads Roundabout; thence in an easterly direction along Highway 5 (the Carrington-Ruby Road) to its junction with Beulah Corner and Highway M (the Beulah-Bushy Park Road); thence along the middle of Highway M to its junction with Bushy Park-Harrow Road; thence along the middle of Bushy Park Road-Harrow Road to its junction with Marchfield-St. Philip Church Road; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Marchfield-St. Philip Church Road to its junction with Church Village-Thickets Road; thence in a westerly direction to its junction with Cox Hill; thence in a northerly direction along the middle of Cox Hill to the junction at Hillview, thence along the middle of Hillview Road in a south westerly direction to monument (B.14), then generally westward to a point which is marked by Monument (B.13); thence in a westerly direction along a line joining this to a point in the gully running from Woodland, marked by Monument (B.12); thence in a southerly direction along this gully to the point at which it is crossed by Highway 4B (the Frenches-Chapel Road); thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Highway 4B to its junction with an unclassified road leading to Edgecumbe; thence in a southerly direction along this unclassified road to its junction with the Edgecumbe-Ebenezer Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Edgecumbe-Ebenezer Road to its junction with Highway 5 (Bridgetown-Windsor Road); thence along Highway 5 to its junction with Lower Greys-Boarded Hall-South District Road; thence in a southerly direction along Lower Greys-Dayrells Hill Road to its junction with Highway R (the Pilgrim-Ridge Road); thence along the middle of Highway R to its junction with the ABC Highway; thence along the middle of the ABC Highway to a point near light pole #499; thence in a southerly direction in a straight line to its junction with the Fairy Valley Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Fairy Valley Road to its junction with the Seawell House-Paragon Road; thence along the middle of the Seawell House-Paragon Road to a straight line leading to a point on the Sea Coast south of Paragon House; thence in an easterly direction along the sea coast to a point on the coast south of the Monument (B.17) (the starting point).

Constituency of St. Thomas

From a point in the centre of the road called Highway 2 (the Springvale-Haggatts Road) opposite to a monument (B.7) placed on the western side of the road in a straight line to the triangulation station known as "Hillaby" S.15 at the end of the Hillaby Tenantry Road; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Hillaby Tenantry Road to its junction with Farmers-Turners Hall Road; thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Farmers-Turners Hall Road to its junction with the Farmers-Plum Tree-Ridgeway Gully; thence in a westerly direction along the Farmers-Plum Tree-Ridgeway Gully to the point at which it is crossed by the Ronald Mapp Highway (the Warrens-Rock Dundo Road); thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Ronald Mapp Highway to its junction with the Luther Johnson Roundabout; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of the Seaview-Reeves Hill Road to a point marked by a monument (B.8) placed on the southern side of the road; thence in a southerly direction to the middle of the Ridgeway-Molyneaux gully; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Ridgeway-Molyneaux gully to the point where it is crossed by the Ronald Mapp Highway; thence in a southerly direction along the Ronald Mapp Highway to its junction with the Bagatelle-Grand View Road; thence along the middle of the Bagatelle-Grand View Road to the point where it crosses the Apple Grove Gully; thence in a southerly then westerly direction along the middle of the Apple Grove

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Gully to a point leading to Terrace Drive Road, Welches Terrace; thence in a westerly direction along the middle of Terrace Drive Road to the Ronald Mapp Highway; thence in a southerly direction to its junction with the Gordon Cummins Highway; thence in an easterly direction along the Gordon Cummins Highway to its junction with Highway 2 at Everton Weekes Roundabout; thence in a north easterly direction along Highway 2 to its junction with the Jackson-Canewood Road; thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the Canewood Road to its junction with Highway E (Hothersal Turning-Proute Village Road); thence in a north-easterly direction along the middle of Highway E to the point where it crosses the Fisherpond-Proute-Bridgefield Gully; thence along the middle of the said gully to the point where it meets the Jack-In-The-Box Gully; thence along the middle of the Jack-In-The-Box Gully to the point where it is crossed by the Hopewell-Walkes Spring Road; then turning right along the middle of the Hopewell-Walkes Spring Road to its junction with Highway E; then turning left along the middle of Highway E to its junction with the Mt.Wilton-Bloomsbury Road; thence turning right along the middle of the Mt. Wilton-Bloomsbury Road to its junction with Highway 2; thence along the middle of Highway 2 to a point in the centre of Highway 2 (the Sturges-Springvale Road) opposite the monument (B.7) (the starting point).
