**CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2)**  
**REGULATIONS, 2009**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 241 of the *Customs Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Customs (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2009*.
2. Regulation 165 of the *Customs Regulations, 1963* is amended L.N. 1963

“(a) persons whose services are requested at least 2 hours before the close of official hours shall be paid in respect of those services for every hour or part thereof at the following rates:
