CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2009

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 241 of the *Customs Act*, makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Customs (Amendment)* (No. 2) Regulations, 2009.
