CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2009

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 241 of the *Customs Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 2009*.

2. The *Customs Regulations, 1963* in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 85 and substituting the following: L.N. 1963/
61.

“Duty-Free allowance to passengers. **85.** The following articles if duly declared by an adult passenger to be for his own personal use shall be admitted without payment of duty:

Potable spirits in any quantity not exceeding one quart in the aggregate or wine not exceeding one quart, but if any passenger imports in his baggage any of the aforesaid articles in any quantity exceeding those specified, he shall pay on the whole quantity of such article.”

3. Paragraph 6 of Section C of Form C23 as set out in the Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (b) and substituting the following:

“(b) All passengers 18 years and over may bring with them wine or spirits not exceeding 1 litre.”
