CUSTOMS (WAREHOUSE RENT AND CHARGES) NOTICE, 1970

Authority: This Notice was given on 30th July, 1970 by the Minister under section 141 of

the Customs Act.

Commencement: 6th August, 1970.

- **1.** This Notice may be cited as the *Customs (Warehouse Rent and Charges) Notice, 1970.*
 - 2. The Minister hereby directs that rent shall be payable as follows
 - (a) on the items of goods specified in the *Schedule*, warehoused in schedule. a Government Warehouse for a period of 12 months or any shorter period, at the rate set out opposite thereto in the *Schedule*;
 - (b) on goods deposited in a Queen's Warehouse, at the rate of 4 cents per cubic foot or \$1.60 per ton for each 24-hour period or part thereof.
- **3.** The Notice relating to the payment of rent and given under section 141 of the Act by the Governor-in-Executive Committee on 8th February, 1963 is hereby cancelled.
