**CUSTOMS TARIFF (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2)**  
**ORDER, 2009**

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 25 of the *Customs Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Customs Tariff (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2009*.

2. Section B of Part II of the Customs Tariff is amended by inserting immediately after item 41A the following as item 41B:

“Motor vehicles, spare parts, tyres and equipment for the Barbados Motoring Federation Inc. Club.

**41B.** (1) Motor vehicles, spare parts, tyres and other equipment including timing, communication and safety equipment imported for the exclusive purpose of a motor racing competition that is sponsored or facilitated by the Barbados Motoring Federation Inc. on a certificate to that effect from the President of the Barbados Motoring Federation Inc. subject to the condition that

- (a) the motor vehicle being imported is a
- (A) saloon or sedan model with a welded safety roll-cage and limited interior trim which is designated to carry two persons;
  - (B) Formula one car or other single seater purpose-built racing car, with a welded safety roll cage and a closed cockpit that is designed for racetrack use only, or

(C) kart designed specifically for racetrack use;

(b) the Comptroller is satisfied that the motor vehicle, spare parts, tyres and other equipment including timing, communication and safety equipment are reasonably required for the purposes of a motor racing competition;

(b) the Comptroller may impose and attach such conditions as to the keeping and rendering of accounts as he considers appropriate in respect of the use and disposal of the motor vehicles, spare parts, tyres and other equipment including timing, communication and safety equipment; and

(d) the person importing the motor vehicle, spare parts, tyres and other equipment including timing, communication, and safety equipment for the motor racing competition is a member of a motor club which is a part of the Barbados Motoring Federation Inc. or a competitor who is not resident in Barbados.

(2) The spare parts, tyres and other equipment referred to in paragraph (1) are as follows:

1. bodyshells;
2. engines;
3. transmissions;
4. rear axles;

5. braking systems;
6. tyres specifically designated for racing competition purposes;
7. helmets;
8. racing suits;
9. fire resistant under garments;
10. driving shoes;
11. driving gloves;
12. seat belts consisting of 4 or more points;
13. seats;
14. fire extinguishers;
15. fire retardants;
16. fire suppression systems;
17. roll cages;
18. marshal's vests and protective clothing;
19. safety flags;
20. safety barriers;
21. rescue equipment;
22. VHP or similar radios;
23. electronic timing lights;
24. electric timing devices;
25. electronic start lights;
26. timing clocks;
27. photocells (transponder and receiver);

28. tripods;
29. headsets;
30. amplifiers;
31. cables;
32. remote devices;
33. laptop computers; and
34. batteries.”
