**DEFENCE (CUSTODY OF PERSONS FOUND  
INSANE) REGULATIONS, 1984**

1984/163.

**Authority:** These regulations were made on 6th June, 1984 by the Defence Board under section 139 of the *Defence Act*.

**Commencement:** 6th June, 1984.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Defence (Custody of Persons Found Insane) Regulations, 1984*. Short title.

2. Where on the trial of an accused person by court-martial, the court makes a finding under subsection (1) or (2) of section 117 of the Act, the accused person shall be kept in custody in such manner as the confirming authority, after considering medical advice, determines. Custody of accused.

3. Where the court-martial mentioned in regulation 2 was held outside Barbados and the accused is transferred to Barbados, the manner in which he shall be kept in custody shall, Custody of accused on transfer to Barbados.

- (a) during the transfer, be determined, after considering medical advice, by the commander of the Force in which the court-martial was held, and
- (b) after arrival in Barbados, be determined by the Chief of Staff after he has considered medical advice.
