**The Constitution of Barbados**

**THE ELECTORAL AND BOUNDARIES COMMISSION  
(REVIEW OF BOUNDARIES) ORDER, 2012**

**WHEREAS**

- (a) the Electoral and Boundaries Commission in accordance with section 41D(1) of the *Constitution* reviewed the number and boundaries of the constituencies into which Barbados is divided and on the 7th September, 2011 submitted a report to the Minister, stating that, in the opinion of the Commission, no alteration is required to the existing number or boundaries of constituencies;
- (b) the House of Assembly on the 5th day of June, 2012 and the Senate on the 29th day of June, 2012, approved a draft of the following order designed to give effect to the recommendation contained in the report; and
- (c) it is expedient to give legal effect to that recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE the Governor-General in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 41D(5) of the *Constitution*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Electoral and Boundaries Commission (Review of Boundaries) Order, 2012*.
2. There is no requirement for any alteration of the existing number or boundaries of constituencies into which Barbados is divided.

3. This Order shall come into force on the next dissolution of Parliament.
