These regulations were made on 1st March, 1976 by the Minister under

section 18(2) of the Electrical Wiremen (Licensing) Act.

Commencement: 1st March, 1976.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electrical Wiremen (Licensing) (Fees) Regulations, 1976.

- 2. (1) An applicant for the issue or renewal of a licence under section 5 or 8A of the Act shall pay to the Board in respect of the issue or renewal of such licence a fee of \$20.
- (2) The fee payable under paragraph (1) shall, in a case where a licence is issued on a date subsequent to the 31st January in any year, be reduced by deducting therefrom \$1.60 for each month which has expired prior to the date of the issue of that licence.
