EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (COVID-19) PROTOCOL (NO. 4) (AMENDMENT) DIRECTIVE, 2020

WHEREAS by paragraph 15 of the *Emergency Management (Covid-19) Order, 2020* (S.I. 2020 No. 16) it is provided that the Prime Minister on the advice of the Chief Medical Officer may issue a directive requiring every person to observe such physical distancing and associated protocols in the interest of public health as may be specified;

AND WHEREAS a public health emergency exists in Barbados;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the *Emergency Management* (*Covid-19*) *Protocol* (*No.4*) *Directive*, 2020;

NOW THEREFORE by virtue of the power and the authority in me vested and on the advice of the Chief Medical Officer aforesaid I do hereby issue the following Directive:

- 1. The *Emergency Management (Covid-19) Protocol (No.4) Directive,* 2020 is amended as follows:
 - (a) in paragraph 10(1), by deleting the words "re-open and";
 - (b) in paragraph 12, by deleting the word "visitor" and substituting the word "traveller"; and
 - (c) in paragraph 9(1), by deleting the word "seek" and substituting the word "obtain".
- 2. This Directive shall come into effect on the 30th day of December, 2020.

Made by the Prime Minister this 29th day of December, 2020.
