EMPLOYMENT EXCHANGES (REGISTRATION AND RECRUITMENT OF WORKERS) REGULATIONS, 1963

L.N. 1963/10.

Made by the Minister under section 4 of the Employment Gap. 345. Exchanges Act.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment Short title. Exchanges (Registration and Recruitment of Workers) Regulations, 1963.
- 2. In these regulations, "registering officer" means any officer of an employment exchange assigned by the Chief Labour Officer to carry into effect the provisions of these regulations.

Registration and Selection for Employment Outside of the Island

3. Every person desiring to be registered at an employment Registration exchange for employment outside of the Island shall supply the for employment outside registering officer with the particulars specified in the Form A of Island. in the Schedule, and such particulars shall, subject to the Schedule. provisions of regulation 5, be entered on a registration card kept S.I. or caused to be kept for this purpose by the Chief Labour Officer in the Form A in the said Schedule.

4. Every person desiring to be considered for selection for Particulars employment outside Barbados shall supply the registering furnished by officer with the particulars specified in the Form B in the persons Schedule, and such particulars shall, subject to the provisions of employment regulation 5, be entered on a registration card kept or caused to outside be kept for this purpose by the Chief Labour Officer in the Form "B" Form B in the said Schedule.

5. (1) A registering officer shall, before entering on the Verification appropriate registration card any particulars supplied pursuant

of particulars.

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to regulations 3 and 4, require satisfactory evidence of identity and age to be provided by the person supplying the particulars, and may require the verification to the satisfaction of the Chief Labour Officer of such other particulars as the Chief Labour Officer may from time to time determine.

- (2) After entering on the appropriate registration card the particulars supplied pursuant to regulations 3 and 4, the registering officer shall require the person supplying such particulars to sign the declaration set out in such registration card.
 - (3) For the purposes of this regulation—

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- (a) a certificate of registration of birth or baptism issued under section 33 of the Registration Act shall be satisfactory evidence of the age of the person named in such certificate; and
- (b) a valid passport, or a recent photograph signed by a justice of the peace, attorney-at-law, magistrate, minister of religion, registered medical practitioner, or notary public, shall be satisfactory evidence of the identity of the person named in such passport or on such photograph.

Condition of recruitment. S.I. 1976/120.

- 6. No person shall be selected for employment outside Barbados unless—
 - (a) such person has supplied a registering officer with the particulars required by regulations 3 and 4;
 - (b) the registering officer is satisfied that the particulars are not false or misleading in any material respect; and
 - (c) the name of and particulars relating to such person have been entered on the registration card provided for by regulation 4 and such person has signed the declaration set out in such registration card.

Issue of identity cards. Form "C" Schedule. S.I. 1976/120.

7. An identity card in the Form C in the Schedule may be issued to every person selected for employment outside Barbados in accordance with the provisions of regulation 6.

Registration for Employment in the Island

8. Every person desiring to be registered at an employment Registration exchange for employment in the Island shall supply the ment in the registering officer with the particulars specified in the Form A Island. in the Schedule, and such particulars shall, subject to regula- Schedule. tion 9, be entered on a registration card kept or caused to be S.I. kept for this purpose by the Chief Labour Officer in the Form A in the said Schedule.

9. (1) A registering officer shall, before entering in the Verification registration card kept under regulation 8 any particulars supplied pursuant to that regulation, require satisfactory evidence of identity to be provided by the persons supplying the particulars, and may require the verification to the satisfaction of the Chief Labour Officer of such other particulars as the S.I. Chief Labour Officer may from time to time determine, and shall, after entering on the registration card any particulars supplied as aforesaid, require the person supplying the particulars to sign the declaration set out in such registration card.

- (2) Sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (3) of regulation 5 shall have effect as regards the verification of particulars of identity for the purposes of this regulation.
- 10. Where a registering officer is satisfied that the particulars Issue of supplied pursuant to the provisions of regulation 8 are not false registration cards. or misleading in any material respect, he shall issue to the person supplying the particulars a registration card in the Form D in Form D the Schedule after such person has signed the declaration required to be signed in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of regulation 9.

General

11. Any person who knowingly supplies to a registering officer Supplying acting in pursuance of regulations 3, 4 or 8 any particulars false particulars. which are false or misleading in any material respect shall be liable on conviction by a court of summary jurisdiction to a fine not exceeding one hundred and twenty dollars or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

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Forgery, fraudulent use of identity and registration cards.

- **12.** Any person who —
- (a) forges; or
- (b) fraudulently alters or uses; or
- (c) permits to be fraudulently altered or used; or
- (d) lends or transfers to any other person an identity card issued under regulation 7 or a registration card issued under regulation 10; or
- (e) with intent to deceive makes or has in his possession any document so closely resembling any such identity card or registration card as to be calculated to deceive,

shall be liable on conviction by a court of summary jurisdiction to a fine not exceeding one hundred and twenty dollars or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Cancellation of registration cards in certain cases. 13. Where any person who has signed the declaration required to be signed by regulation 5 or 9 is convicted of an offence under regulation 11 or 12, then, in addition to any penalty which may be imposed on such person under regulation 11 or 12 aforesaid, the magistrate before whom such person is convicted shall order the cancellation of any registration card kept in relation to such person pursuant to the provisions of regulation 3, 4 or 8.

Manner of proving supply of particulars.

14. In any proceedings brought under these regulations, the production from proper custody of a registration card kept pursuant to the provisions of regulation 3, 4 or 8 and containing a declaration signed as provided for by the said regulations, shall be *prima facie* proof that the particulars contained in such registration card were supplied by the person by whom the declaration contained in that registration card was signed.
