EXEMPT INSURANCE (DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS) 1991

1991/43.

- 1. The Minister on the 25th April, 1991 and in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 16 of the Exempt Insurance Act hereby delegates the following functions to the Supervisor of Insurance:
 - (a) the consent to the incorporation of an exempt insurance company, approval of articles of incorporation and any amendments thereto under section 5;
 - (b) the receipt of applications for licences to engage in exempt insurance under 6(1);
 - (c) the investigation into companies applying for licences to engage in exempt insurance in pursuance of section 7;
 - (d) the issue of a licence under section 8(1);
 - (e) the refusal of licences under section 8(1) subject to the approval of the Minister;
 - (f) under section 9
 - (i) the specification of the class or classes of business in which the licensee may engage under subsection (1) thereof;
 - (ii) the attachment of conditions to the issue of a licence in accordance with subsection (2) thereof;
 - (iii) the granting of approval as may be required under subsection (3) thereof;
 - (g) the revocation and suspension of a licence under sections 12 and 13 respectively, subject to the approval of the Minister;
 - (h) under section 17
 - (i) the approval of minimum capital requirement for companies not engaging in immediate exempt insurance business:

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- (ii) the approval of capital requirements;
- (i) the decision to extend the 6 months period within which financial statements are to be submitted in pursuance of section 18(1);
- (j) the receipt of applications from holding companies and the approval of the registration of holding companies under section 28C.
