ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Financial Administration (Public Short title. Enterprise Investment Fund) (Repeal) Act, 2010.
- 2. In this Act, "enterprise" means an enterprise specified in the Interpretation. Schedule.

Repeal of Cap. 5A.

3. The Financial Administration (Public Enterprise Investment Fund) Act is repealed.

Disposal of the resources of the Public Enterprise Investment Fund.

- **4.** All of the resources of the Public Enterprise Investment Fund which consist of
 - (a) the revenue representing the proceeds of the disposal of an enterprise, or shares or other interests in an enterprise, owned by the Government;
 - (b) money that Parliament has provided for the purposes of the Public Enterprise Investment Fund;
 - (c) all sums that represent the payment of debts or the discharge of any liability to the Government by an enterprise;
 - (d) all sums that were made available to the Public Enterprise Investment Fund by way of gift, grant or otherwise

shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund on the date of the commencement of this Act.

Commencement. 5. This Act shall come into operation on the 10th day of November, 2010.
