FIRE SERVICE (ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS, 1981

1981/220.

Authority: These regulations were made on 17th December, 1981 by the Minister under section 50 of the Fire Service Act.

Commencement: 28th December, 1981.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Service (Allowances) Regulations, 1981.
- 2. Members of the Service shall be paid allowances at the following rates:
 - (a) in the case of Station Officer, a washing allowance at the rate of \$384 per annum in respect of the period 1st April, 1979 to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$624 per annum;
 - (b) in the case of subordinate fire officer and fire officer, a washing allowance at the rate of \$276 per annum in respect of the period 1st April, 1979 to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$552 per annum;
 - (c) in the case of superior fire officer other than station officer a uniform allowance at the rate of \$840 per annum in respect of the period 1st April, 1979 to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$1 260 per annum; and
 - (d) in the case of designated drivers, a responsibility allowance at the rate of \$216 per annum for the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981 and thereafter at the rate of \$280 per annum.
