## FISHERIES (MANAGEMENT) REGULATIONS, 1998

1998/102.

**Authority:** These Regulations were made on 27th July, 1998 by the Minister under section 46 of the *Fisheries Act*.

Commencement: 30th July, 1998.

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the *Fisheries (Management) Regulations*, 1998.
  - 2. In these Regulations,
- "closed area" means any area declared by the Minister, by notice published in the *Official Gazette*, as an area within which the fishing of designated species of fish or by designated fishing methods is prohibited;
- "closed season" means any period declared by the Minister, by notice published in the *Official Gazette*, as a period during which fishing of designated species of fish or by designated fishing methods is prohibited;
- "ornamental fish" means live fish kept, or suitable for keeping, in aquaria;
- "SCUBA" means self-contained underwater breathing apparatus;
- "sea egg" means the white sea urchin *Tripneustes ventricosus*;
- "turtle" means all species of marine turtle.
- **3.** The Minister shall designate, by notice published in the *Official Gazette*,
  - (a) fishing methods which are prohibited; and

- (b) species of fish which may not be harvested, during the closed season and in the closed areas.
- **4.** No person shall use a trammel or entangling net, or any net that is so hung and deployed as to catch fish primarily by entanglement.
  - **5.** (1) No person shall use for fishing
  - (a) a seine net the smallest mesh of which when stretched is less than 3.81 centimetres in dimension;
  - (b) a pelagic drift net of a size greater than 2.5 kilometres in length; or
  - (c) a fish trap the mesh of which is less than 3.18 centimetres in dimension.
- (2) Every fish trap shall be fitted with an escape panel of a size and design approved by the Chief Fisheries Officer.
- (3) Every fish trap shall be marked for identification in a manner approved by the Chief Fisheries Officer.
  - **6.** (1) No person shall
  - (a) have in his possession;
  - *(b)* sell;
  - (c) purchase; or
  - (d) harm

any lobster which is carrying eggs.

- (2) No person shall remove eggs from a lobster.
- **7.** (1) No person shall
- (a) have in his possession;
- (b) sell or expose for sale; or

- (c) purchase
- any turtle or part thereof or turtle eggs.
  - (2) No person shall fish for or ensuare any turtle.
- (3) No person shall disturb or endanger any turtle nest or remove from a nest any turtle eggs.
  - **8.** No person shall fish for any sea eggs
  - (a) during the closed season;
  - (b) with the assistance of SCUBA; or
  - (c) in a closed area.
  - 9. No person shall
  - (a) have in his possession;
  - (b) sell or expose for sale;
  - (c) purchase

any sea eggs during the closed season, unless such sea eggs were obtained with the written permision of the Chief Fisheries Officer.

- **10.** A person who owns and uses
- (a) a vessel; or
- (b) fishing gear

to fish for sea eggs during the closed season or in a closed area is guilty of an offence.

- 11. No person shall wantonly injure or destroy any sea eggs.
- **12.** No person shall land a yellowfin tuna, or a bigeye tuna, less than 3.2 kilogrammes live weight.

- 13. No person shall fish for any ornamental fish or aquatic flora, except with the written permission of the Chief Fisheries Officer and in accordance with any conditions which he may specify.
- **14.** No person shall take, injure, destroy or fish for coral, except with the written permission of the Chief Fisheries Officer and in accordance with any conditions which he may specify.
- **15.** Any person who contravenes these Regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$50 000 or to imprisonment for a term of 2 years or to both.
- **16.** These Regulations shall not apply to any fisheries operations which are conducted solely for the purpose of fisheries research and where
  - (a) permission has been granted in respect of such operations pursuant to section 26 of the Act; and
  - (b) the operations are carried out in accordance with any condition stipulated in the permission.
