HEALTH SERVICES (PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITAL) (ENCEPHALOGRAPH MACHINE FEES) REGULATIONS, 1989

Authority:

These regulations were made on 4th September, 1989 by the Minister under paragraph (z) of section 10 (1) of the *Health Services Act*.

Commencement: 25th September, 1989.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Services (Psychiatric Hospital) (Encephalograph Machine Fees) Regulations, 1989.
 - 2. In these regulations
- "E.E.G. service" means the use of the encephalograph machine at the Psychiatric Hospital;
- "Hospital Director" has the meaning assigned to it by section 14 of the Mental Health Act;

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"medical practitioner" has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Medical Registration Act*.

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- 3. A person who is a citizen or permanent resident of Barbados is eligible for free E.E.G. service, unless that person enters into a private arrangement with a medical practitioner for medical services to be provided to that person.
- 4. The fees payable to the Hospital Director in respect of each use of the E.E.G. service
 - (a) by a citizen or permanent resident who enters into the private arrangement mentioned in regulation 3 shall be those specified in paragraph 1 of the Schedule; and

(b) by a person who is not a citizen or permanent resident of Barbados shall be those specified in paragraph 2 of the Schedule.
