**IMMIGRATION (PORTS OF ENTRY AND DEPARTURE)  
REGULATIONS, 2014**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 31(1) of the *Immigration Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Immigration (Ports of Entry and Departure) Regulations, 2014*.
2. The following places in Barbados are designated as ports of entry and departure for the examination, by immigration officers, of persons seeking to enter, entering, seeking to depart or departing Barbados:
  - (a) the Port of Bridgetown comprising the Careenage, the landing place at the Baggage Warehouse and the Deep Water Harbour in the parish of Saint Michael;
  - (b) the Grantley Adams International Airport, in the parish of Christ Church;
  - (c) Port St. Charles, in the parish of Saint Peter.

3. The Immigration (*Ports of Entry*) Regulations, 1976 (S.I. 1976 No. 25) are revoked.
