LAND (ADJUDICATION OF RIGHTS AND INTERESTS) (DECLARATION OF REGISTRA-TION DISTRICT) ORDER, 1990

1990/39.

Authority: This order was made on 12th April, 1990 by the Minister under section 10 of the Land (Adjudication of Rights and Interests) Act.

Commencement: 1st May, 1990.

1. This Order may be cited as the Land (Adjudication of Rights Short title. and Interests) (Declaration of Registration District) Order, 1990.

2. In this order "Regulations" means the Land (Adjudication of Rights and Interests) Regulations, 1988.

Definition. 1988/75.

3. The area described in the First Schedule and delineated in yellow in the Second Schedule is hereby declared a registration district for the purposes of the adjudication of all titles to land and all rights and interests over land within that district in accordance with the Act and the Regulations.

Registration district. First Schedule. Second Schedule.


4. The presentation of claims or applications respecting title to land or rights or interests over land shall commence on 1st day of May, 1990 in the manner prescribed by the Regulations.

Presentation of claims etc

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL THAT area of land situate in the parishes of St. Michael, St. James and St. Thomas, comprising Thorpes, Halls Village, Prior Park, Prior View Heights, Prior Park Gardens, Prior Hill, Prior Park Heights, Clermont, Meadowvale Heights, Warrens Park (North), Warrens Terrace, Warrens Terrace (West) and Warrens and starting from the junction of the Husbands and Clermont Roads and then northwards along the Husbands Road to the junction at Thorpes with the road leading to St. John the Baptist Church; then along this road in a generally easterly direction to its junction with the Prior Park Road and easterly along this to its junction with Highway 2A; then in a southerly direction along Highway 2A to its junction with Clermont Road; then in a westerly direction along Clermont Road back to the starting point.
