LAND VALUATION (FEES) REGULATIONS, 1974

Authority: These Regulations were made on 14th August, 1974 by the Minister under section 43 of the *Land Valuation Act*.

Commencement: 1st September, 1974.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Land Valuation (Fees) Regulations*, 1974.

2. The sum to be deposited as security for the due prosecution of an appeal under section 20 of the Act shall be in accordance with the scale set out in Part I of the *Schedule*. Schedule.

3. The fees payable under section 28(2) or 29, as the case may be, of the Act and remuneration payable under section 30(3) thereof, shall be as specified in Part II of the *Schedule*.
