LAW REVISION ORDER, 2008

The Law Revision Commissioner, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 15 of the *Law Revision Act*, makes the following Order with the approval of the Governor-General:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Law Revision Order, 2008*, and is referred to on the pages comprised in the Laws as "L.R.O. 2008". Citation.
2. In this Order, the expression "the Laws" means the Laws of Barbados. Interpretation.
3. The pages specified in the third column of the *First Schedule* are hereby directed to be removed from the Laws in accordance with that Schedule. Removal of certain pages. First Schedule.
4. The pages specified in the third column of the *Second Schedule* are hereby authorised to be included in the Laws in accordance with that Schedule. Inclusion of certain pages. Second Schedule.
5. The removal of pages from, and the inclusion of pages in, the Laws in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 shall have effect from 23rd May, 2012. Date of removal and inclusion.
6. It is hereby declared that the pages included in the Laws in accordance with this Order state the law in force on 31st December, 2008, unless a different date is stated on any such page. Revision date.
