# LIQUOR LICENCES REGULATIONS, 1957 L.N. 1957/122.

Made by the Minister under section 96 of the Liquor Licences Cap. 182. Act.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor Licences Regulations, 1957.

2. In these regulations, "the Act" means the Liquor Cap. 182. Licences Act.

3. Every application for the grant or renewal of a general wholesale licence, a wholesale licence, a retail licence, an hotel licence, or a restaurant licence, shall be in the Form A in the Schedule to these regulations, and every application for the transfer of any of such licences shall be in the form B, C, or D in the said Schedule.

4. Every application for the grant or renewal of a members' club licence or a proprietary club licence shall be in the form E in the said Schedule.

5. Every application for the grant of an occasional licence shall be in the form F in the said Schedule.

6. The notice required by section 19 (1) of the Act to be lodged by a person opposing the grant, renewal or transfer of a licence shall be in the form G in the said Schedule.

7. Every licence issued under the Act shall be in one of the forms H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, or P in the said Schedule.

8. Every application for registration of a club shall be in the form Q in the said Schedule.

9. The notice of a sitting of a licensing authority required to be published by section 16 of the Act shall be in the form R in the said Schedule.

(f) for altering the appropriate register where a club is removed to other premises, \$10.
