**MAGISTRATE'S COURTS
(HOURS OF BUSINESS) ORDER, 2006**

2006/35.

Authority: This Order was made on 19th May, 2006 by the Chief Justice under section 9 of the *Magistrate's Courts Act*.

Commencement: 25th May 2006.

1. The sittings of the Magistrate's Courts in Barbados shall be held on every day not being a Saturday, Sunday or Public Holiday between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.

2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Notice, one court of those courts comprising the District "A" Magisterial jurisdiction shall be open for business between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 11.30 a.m. on Saturdays.

3. Nothing in this Notice shall prevent a Magistrate from extending the closing time mentioned in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, provided that the Magistrate obtains the consent of the parties or their attorneys-at-law to extend the said time.

4. Nothing in this Notice shall prevent a Magistrate from ceasing attendance before 4.00 p.m. on any day if the business of the court has been disposed of prior to that time.
