- **1.** This Order may be cited as the *District 'A' Magistrate's Court (Special Court) Order*, 2007.
- 2. With effect from 10th December, 2007 and until further order, certain premises situate at the site of the former Glendairy Prison are hereby appointed as a Magistrate's Court for the hearing of cases assigned to the criminal jurisdiction of the District 'A' Magistrate's Court.
- **3.** The said premises and the court thereat shall be known as the Special Court, District 'A' Magistrate's Court and the Magistrate assigned to this Court shall hear and determine all types of criminal cases.
- **4.** The hours of business of the said Court shall be 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. or such other times as may be convenient to the Magistrate.
