Miscellaneous Controls

MISCELLANEOUS CONTROLS (IMPORTATION AND EXPORTATION OF GOODS) (PROHIBITION) (RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS) REGULATIONS, 2004

Authority: These Regulations were made on 14th December, 2004 by the Minister under section 3(2) of the *Miscellaneous Controls Act*.

Commencement: 30th December, 2004.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Miscellaneous Controls* (*Importation and Exportation of Goods*) (*Prohibition*) (*Radioactive Materials*) Regulations, 2004.

2. No person shall, except under the authority of a licence granted by the Minister, import into Barbados

- (a) any goods specified in the *Schedule*; or Schedule.
- (b) any goods referred to in paragraph (a) that are intransit or in transhipment to any country.

3. No person shall, except under the authority of a licence granted by the Minister, export from Barbados

- (a) any goods specified in the *Schedule*; or
- (b) any goods referred to in paragraph (a) with intent to tranship or cause the goods to be transhipped to any country.

4. The licence referred to in paragraph 2 or 3 may be subject to such conditions as the Minister may specify in the licence.

5. Any person who imports or exports any goods in contravention of these Regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$20 000 or to imprisonment for a term of 2 years; and the goods may be forfeited.
