An Act to amend the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*, Cap. 47 to provide for an increase in the number of persons who may serve on the National Insurance Board.

[Commencement: 28th December, 2017]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *National Insurance and Social Security (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 2017*.

Amendment of section 3 of Cap. 47

2. *Section 3 of the National Insurance and Social Security Act, Cap. 47, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by deleting subsection (1) and substituting the following:*

“(1) There shall be established, for the purposes of this Act, a body to be called the National Insurance Board comprised as follows:

- (a) 2 persons to be appointed by the Minister by instrument in writing as representatives of employers’ associations;
- (b) 2 persons to be appointed by the Minister by instrument in writing as representatives of trade unions;
- (c) 3 other persons to be appointed by the Minister by instrument in writing;
- (d) the Chief Labour Officer, *ex officio*, or his nominee;
- (e) the Director of Finance and Economic Affairs, *ex officio*, or his nominee; and
- (f) the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry responsible for Social Security, *ex officio*, or his nominee.”

Amendment of section 7 of Cap. 47

3. *Section 7 of the principal Act is amended, in subsection (4), by deleting the word “4” and substituting the word “5”.*
