## National Insurance and Social Security Act

#### CAP. 47

## NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY (BENEFITS) ORDER, 2014

The National Insurance Board, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 25A of the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *National Insurance and Social Security* (Benefits) Order, 2014.

2. With effect from  $6^{th}$  January, 2014, the amount to be paid weekly as

- (a) old age contributory pension; and
- (b) invalidity pension

shall not be less than \$179 per week.

3. With effect from 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2014, an insured person who on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2013 had been entitled to

- (a) an old age contributory pension;
- (b) a survivor's pension;
- (c) a death benefit; or
- (d) an invalidity pension

shall be paid an additional amount of 2.16 per cent of the pension benefit to which that person had been entitled on  $31^{st}$  December, 2013.

4. With effect from  $1^{st}$  January, 2014,

(a) a funeral grant shall be an amount of \$1 995; and

(b) a maternity grant shall be an amount of \$1 150.

5. The National Insurance and Social Security (Benefits) Order, 2013 (S.I. 2013 No.104) is revoked.
