**NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL
SECURITY (EMPLOYMENT INJURY (APPOINTED
DAY)) ORDER, 1970**

S.I. 1971/3.

Authority: This order was made on 30th December, 1970 by the Minister under section 50 of the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*. Cap. 47.

Commencement: 4th January, 1971.

1. This Order may be cited as the *National Insurance and Social Security (Employment Injury (Appointed Day)) Order, 1970*.

2. The 4th day of January, 1971, shall be the appointed day

(a) for the purposes of subsection (1) of section 14 of the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*, and

(b) in respect of persons who are insured on or after the said date pursuant to subsection (1) of the said section 14 and their employers, for the purposes of subsection (1) of section 15 of the Act.

3. Any person or authority entrusted with the performance of functions under any regulations made under the said Act (whether or not such regulations are in operation) may perform any such function at any time after the making of this order for the purpose of ensuring that, as from the date specified in paragraph 2, employed persons shall be insured under the Act and that contributions shall be paid thereunder by the employers of such employed persons.
