NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY
(INSURABLE EARNINGS) (NO. 2) ORDER, 2010

The National Insurance Board, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 19A of the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *National Insurance and Social Security (Insurable Earnings) (No. 2) Order, 2010*.

2. With effect from 1st January, 2011, the maximum earnings on which contributions are payable are,

(a) in the case of workers paid on a monthly basis, \$4,090 per month;
and

(b) in the case of workers paid on a weekly basis, \$944 per week.

3. With effect from 1st January, 2011, the maximum insurable earnings of a self-employed person are,

(a) \$12,270 per calendar quarter; or

(b) \$49,080 per annum.

4. The *National Insurance and Social Security (Insurable Earnings) Order, 2010* is revoked. S.I. 2010
No. 9.
