**PARAMEDICAL PROFESSIONS (REGISTRATION
FEES) REGULATIONS, 1976**

S.I. 1976/20.

Made by the Minister under section 23 (2) of the Paramedical Professions Act. Cap. 372C.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Paramedical Professions (Registration Fees) Regulations, 1976.

2. Subject to section 12 of the Act, the fee payable to the Registrar for first registration under section 7 of the Act shall be—

- (a) twenty dollars, in the case of a person who applies to be registered in respect of a paramedical profession specified in paragraph 8 of the First Schedule to the Act; and
- (b) fifty dollars, in the case of a person who applies to be registered in respect of any other paramedical profession.

3. Subject to section 12 of the Act, the annual registration fee payable to the Registrar under section 9 (2) of the Act shall be—

- (a) twenty dollars, in the case of a person who applies for a Practising Certificate in respect of a paramedical profession specified in paragraphs 8 and 9 of the First Schedule to the Act; and
- (b) fifty dollars, in the case of a person who applies for a Practising Certificate in respect of any other paramedical profession.
