**PHARMACY (QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION)  
OF PHARMACISTS) REGULATIONS, 1986**

**Authority:** These Regulations were made on 21st May, 1986 by the Pharmacy Council, with the approval of the Minister, under section 34 of the *Pharmacy Act*.

**Commencement:** 26th May, 1986.

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the *Pharmacy (Qualifications for Registration of Pharmacists) Regulations, 1986*. Short title.

**2.** The qualifications for registration as a pharmacist are

Qualifications for registration.

(a) the Barbados Community College Certificate in basic pharmacy and certification from the Barbados Community College that the person has satisfactorily completed 6 months pharmacy internship in Barbados;

(b) a degree in pharmacy from a University or College of Pharmacy recognised by the Council;

(c) a diploma or certificate granted by a body or institution outside of Barbados, which diploma or certificate is recognised by the Council as being equivalent to the qualification specified in paragraph (a);

(d) an Associate Degree in pharmacy from the Barbados Community College and certification from the Barbados Community College that the person has satisfactorily completed 6 months pharmacy internship in Barbados.
