PLANT PEST AND DISEASE (ERADICATION) ORDER, 1996

Authority: This Order was made on 12th July, 1996 by the Minister under section 3(1)(a)

of the Plant Pest and Disease (Eradication) Act.

Commencement: 25th July, 1996.

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the *Plant Pest and Disease* (*Eradication*) Order, 1996.
- **2.** The plant pests and diseases that are to be eradicated under the *Plant Pest and Disease (Eradication) Act* are declared to be those set out in the first and second columns of the *Schedule* respectively.

3. The host plants and alternate host plants of the plant pests and diseases referred to in paragraph 2 are declared to be those set out in the third and fourth columns of the *Schedule* respectively.
