POLICE (BAND FEES) REGULATIONS, 1968

1968/34.

Authority:

These Regulations were made on 18th March, 1968 by the 1982/151. Commissioner of Police and approved by the Minister under section 78 of the Police Act.

Cap. 167.

Commencement: 1st April, 1968.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Police* (Band Fees) Regulations, 1968.
- 2. The fees specified in the Schedule shall, except as hereinafter provided, be chargeable in respect of the services of the Royal Barbados Police Band.
- 3. For engagements of longer duration than the times specified in the Schedule the Commissioner of Police may, in his discretion, increase the fees.
- 4. No fees shall be chargeable for engagements of an official nature, and the Commissioner of Police may, with the approval of the Minister, waive or reduce the fees chargeable for engagements of a charitable nature.
- 5. Where the Band or a section of the Band is hired for a series of engagements by the same organisation, the Commissioner of Police may, in his discretion, charge a fee covering the series of engagements.
- 6. The Commissioner of Police may, in addition to any fee he may charge pursuant to regulations 2 and 3 in respect of the services of the Band, charge a further fee for the transportation of the Band to and from any engagement.
- 7. All fees payable under these regulations shall be paid in advance into the Public Treasury.
- 8. The sum of two-thirds of any fees paid to the Commissioner of Police by the Accountant-General in accordance with the provisions of section 43 of the Police Act shall be distributed cap. 167. among the members of the Band as follows
