**POLICE (FEES FOR SPECIAL EMPLOYMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1968**

Authority: These regulations were made on 16th March, 1968 by the Commissioner of Police and approved by the Minister under section 78 of the *Police Act*.

Commencement: 4th April, 1968.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Police (Fees for Special Employment) Regulations, 1968*.

2. Subject to the provisions of the Act and of these regulations, the Commissioner of Police may, in his discretion, permit members of the Force to be employed on duties other than duties prescribed by or under the Act.

3. (1) Subject to these regulations, there shall be charged in respect of the services of members of the Force who are employed pursuant to regulation 2 and who are of the ranks set out in the *Schedule* the several fees specified opposite thereto in the second column of that *Schedule*.

(2) In the case of members of the Force of the mounted branch an additional fee of \$8 per horse shall be charged.

(3) For the purposes of these regulations, the length of the period of duty of a member of the Force shall be calculated from the time at which the member of the Force reports for duty at the function for which he is engaged.

(4) The minimum period of time for which a member of the Force may be employed pursuant to these regulations shall be 2 hours.

4. The Commissioner of Police may, with the approval of the Minister, waive or reduce the fees chargeable for the services of members of the Force employed at functions held for charitable purposes.

5. The Commissioner of Police may require all fees payable under these regulations to be paid in advance into the office of the Commissioner at Police Headquarters by the person or organisation requesting the services of members of the Force.

6. Where the services of members of the Force are required for a series of engagements by the same person or organisation, the Commissioner of Police may, in his discretion, charge a fee covering the series of engagements. Any such fee shall be agreed on by the Commissioner of Police and the person or organisation concerned before the commencement of the series of engagements.

7. All fees paid in respect of the services of members of the Force employed pursuant to these regulations shall be disposed of as follows

- (a) Where the member of the Force is employed during his normal duty or reserve period, the fees shall be paid to the credit of the Police Sports Fund;
- (b) Where the member of the Force is employed during his normal weekly rest day or off-duty period, the fees shall be paid to him;
- (c) Where members of the mounted branch of the Force are employed, the fees charged in respect of the horses shall be paid into the Public Treasury by the Commissioner of Police.
