POLICE (MISCELLANEOUS FEES) REGULATIONS, 1984

1984/72.

Authority:

These Regulations were made on 9th April, 1984 by the Commissioner of Police and approved by the Minister under section 78 of the Police

Commencement: 3rd May, 1984.

- Regulations may be cited as the *Police* 1. These (Miscellaneous Fees) Regulations, 1984.
- 2. The fee payable for a service rendered in accordance with a matter set out in Column 1 of the First Schedule shall be the fee First set out in Column 2 opposite that matter.

Schedule.

3. The fee payable in respect of the services of a ballistic or handwriting expert rendered by a member of the Force and referred to in Column 1 of the Second Schedule is that set out in second Column 2 opposite those services.

Schedule.

- 4. The fee payable in respect of the services of a ballistic or handwriting expert rendered by a member of the Force and referred to in regulation 3 is to be disbursed as follows:
 - (a) two-thirds of the fee shall be paid to the member; and
 - (b) the remaining one-third shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund by the Commissioner.
- 5. The Commissioner may require all fees payable in respect of the services referred to in regulation 3 to be paid in advance into the office of the Commissioner by the person requesting those services.
