**POLICE (TRAFFIC (OPENING OF
LEGISLATURE)) RULES, 1965**

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the approval of
the Minister under section 23 of the Police Act.

Cap. 167.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Police (Traffic (Opening of Legislature)) Rules, 1965.

2. For the purposes of these rules, "vehicle" includes motor vehicles, bicycles, carts, carriages, hand-carts, and all other machines for the portage of persons or goods.

3. Except as hereinafter provided, no person driving, riding or in charge of a vehicle shall, during any opening of the Legislature, enter—

- (a) Trafalgar Square from its junction with High Street to its junction with Rickett Street;
- (b) Trafalgar Street from its junction with Trafalgar Square to its junction with Marhill Street;
- (c) Rickett Street; or
- (d) the Public Buildings Yard.

Such Streets and areas will be closed to all vehicular traffic, except to vehicles conveying persons to and from the ceremony.

4. Drivers, riders, or persons in charge of vehicles shall at once obey any order given to them by any member of the Police Force in uniform.

5. Drivers of vehicles conveying persons to the ceremony shall enter the Public Buildings Yard by the South Gate and leave by way of the North Gate.

6. Drivers of vehicles returning to the Public Buildings Yard for persons attending the ceremony shall enter by the North Gate and leave by way of the South Gate.

7. Vehicles bearing the sticker " B " will be allowed to park in the Public Buildings Yard. All other vehicles will park on Palmetto Square, Rickett Street, or such other streets as directed by a member of the Police Force.
