POLICE (TRAFFIC (AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL EXHIBITION)) RULES, 1965

L.N. 1965/ 28.

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the approval of the Minister under section 23 of the Police Act.

Cap. 167.

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Police (Traffic (Agricultural and Industrial Exhibition)) Rules, 1965.
- 2. (1) These rules shall apply to the control of traffic on those occasions when the Annual Agricultural and Industrial Exhibition is held at Queen's Park.
- (2) For the purposes of these rules, "vehicles" includes motor vehicles, bicycles, carts, carriages, hand-carts, and all other machines used for the portage of persons or goods.
- **3.** The following streets and roads shall be one-way to all vehicular traffic—
 - (a) Crumpton Street from its junction with Roebuck Street to its junction with Constitution Road;
 - (b) Constitution Road from its junction with Belmont Road to its junction with Crumpton Street;
 - (c) St. Michael's Row from its junction with Crumpton Street to its junction with Spry Street.
- 4. Drivers, riders or persons in charge of vehicles approaching Queen's Park shall do so only by way of—
 - (a) Belmont and Constitution Roads;
 - (b) Roebuck and Crumpton Streets.
- 5. Drivers, riders or persons in charge of vehicles approaching by way of Belmont and Constitution Roads may park their vehicles on Constitution Road facing north, between the East Gate and West Boundary of Queen's College, or on the Constitution parking area.

- **6.** Drivers, riders or persons in charge of vehicles approaching by way of Roebuck Street and Crumpton Street may park their vehicles on Crumpton Street, or in the Church Village parking area.
- 7. Drivers, riders or persons in charge of vehicles shall at once obey any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform.
