POLICE (TRAFFIC (RACES AT GARRISON SAVANNAH)) RULES, 1965

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the approval of the Minister under section 23 of the Police Act.

Cap. 167

- 1. (1) These Rules may be cited as the Police (Traffic (Races at Garrison Savannah)) Rules, 1965.
- (2) These rules shall apply to the control of traffic on the occasions when horse races are held at the Garrison Savannah.
- 2. For the purposes of these rules, "vehicles" includes motor vehicles, bicycles, carts, carriages, hand-carts, and all other machines used for the portage of persons or goods.
- 3. The Garrison Road (that is the road around the Garrison Savannah) shall be one-way to all vehicles.
- 4. The drivers, riders, or persons in charge of vehicles travelling on the Garrison Road shall proceed in one direction only and shall keep the Savannah on their right.
- 5. Drivers, riders, or persons in charge of vehicles shall at once obey any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform.
