BARBADOS POLICE FORCE (ALLOWANCES)
REGULATIONS, 1981

1981/212.

Authority: These regulations were made on 7th December, 1981 by the Minister under sections 50 and 79 of the *Police Act*.

Commencement: 14th December, 1981.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Barbados Police Force (Allowances) Regulations, 1981*.

2. Gazetted police officers shall be paid an allowance in lieu of uniform at the rate of \$840 *per annum* in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$1,260 *per annum*.

3. Members of the force employed as detectives in the Criminal Investigation Division shall be paid a detective allowance at the following rates:

- (a) Gazetted Officers at the rate of \$660 *per annum* in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$1,140 *per annum*;
- (b) Inspector at the rate of \$600 *per annum* in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$1,020 *per annum*;
- (c) Station Sergeant and Sergeant at the rate of \$540 *per annum* in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$960 *per annum*; and
- (d) other ranks at the rate of \$480 *per annum* in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$840 *per annum*.

4. Inspector, subordinate police officer and constable required to do duty in plain clothes shall receive an allowance at the rate of \$840 *per annum* in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$720 *per annum*.

5. Inspector, subordinate police officer and constable shall be paid a washing allowance at the following rates:

- (a) Inspector, at the rate of \$420 *per annum* in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$660 *per annum*; and
- (b) Subordinate police officer and constable, at the rate of \$312 *per annum* in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$600 *per annum*.

6. Subordinate police officer and constable who attend court or perform any other duty outside their station and beyond a radius of 4 miles from their station for a period of 6 hours or more in any 1 day shall be paid a subsistence allowance at the rate of \$5 for each day they performed the duty in respect of the period 1st April, 1979, to 31st March, 1981, and thereafter at the rate of \$7.50 for each day they perform the duty.

7. Where a member of the Force in receipt of an allowance under regulation 4 or 5 is absent from duty through illness for a period exceeding 28 days, the payment of such an allowance ceases during the period of his illness that exceeds 28 days.

8. Drivers of vehicles, riders of vehicles, riders of horses, farriers and dog handlers shall be paid a responsibility allowance at the rate of \$600 *per annum* with effect from 1st April, 1981.

9. Allowances under these regulations are payable in accordance with section 79 (2) of the Act.
