**POST OFFICE (EXTRA DUTY)  
REGULATIONS, 1980**

**Authority:**      These regulations were made on 17th June, 1980 by the Minister under section 59 of the *Post Office Act*.

**Commencement:**      1st January, 1981.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Post Office (Extra Duty) Regulations, 1980*.

2. The Postmaster General may, with the approval of the Chief Personnel Officer, require the attendance of any officer of the Post Office, including messengers, at any time for the performance of such functions as may be necessary in connection with the business of the Post Office; and he may with such approval on any occasion nominate any such officer for performance of extra functions outside normal office hours.

3. (1) The Postmaster General may, with the approval of the Chief Personnel Officer assign such officers of the Post Office as he deems proper to perform special duties in connection with the receipt and despatch of overseas mail at such times and hours he considers necessary.

(2) Officers assigned special duties under paragraph (1) shall render to each other such assistance as may be necessary.
