## POST OFFICE (MAIL NOTICE SERVICE) REGULATIONS, 1980

Authority:

These regulations were made on 17th June, 1980 by the Minister under

section 59 of the Post Office Act.

Commencement:

1st January, 1981.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Mail Notice Service) Regulations, 1980.
- 2. There is available at the Post Office for the convenience of the public the following mail notice services
  - (a) Service A, for the members of the public generally; and
  - (b) Service B, for members of Commercial Organisations.
- 3. An application for a mail notice service must be made in writing to the Postmaster General whose decision regarding the granting of the service is final.
- 4. (1) Where an application for a mail notice service has been granted under these regulations,
  - (a) the Postmaster General shall in the case of Service A, deliver a copy of each overseas mail notice or amended mail notice to the subscriber to that service; and
  - (b) in the case of Service B, deliver a copy of the mail notice or amended notice to the address of the subscriber to that service or by placing it in his private letter box.
- (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1)(b) where delivery as specified in that paragraph is not practical by reason of urgency, the Postmaster General has a discretion to telephone the particulars of a mail notice or amended notice to each branch of the relevant commercial organisation.
- 5. The charges payable in respect of mail service notices are those specified in the *Schedule*.

6. Any person who before the commencement of these regulations has paid any amount in respect of the annual charge for a mail notice service must not later than 1 month after that date, pay to the Postmaster General the difference between that amount and the charges specified in the *Schedule* in respect of that mail notice service.

\$ 3.00 per month or \$30.00 per annum

2. In the case of Service "B"

\$ 4.00 per month or \$40.00 per annum.
