## PROBATES AND LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION (RESEALING) RULES, 1981

1981/92.

Authority: These rules were made on 7th May, 1981 by the Judicial Advisory Council under section 8 of the Probates and Letters of Administration (Resealing) Act.

Commencement: 1st August, 1982.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Probates and Letters of Administration (Resealing) Rules, 1981.

2. Notice of the re-sealing of any probates or letters of administration shall be sent by the Registrar to the Court from which the grant is issued.

3. The Registrar shall cause to be recorded in the Registration Office the grant of probates or administration duly resealed.

4. The following fees are payable to the Registrar on application for resealing probates or letters of administration:

- (1) Where the estate does not exceed \$1,500 \$25.00
- (2) Where the estate exceeds \$1,500 but does not exceed \$10,000 \$50.00
- (3) Where the estate exceeds \$10,000
- (a) Fee on application \$30.00
- (b) Fee on issue of or on resealing grant on gross value of estate
  - (i) Exceeding \$10,000 but not exceeding \$50,000 \$150.00
  - (ii) Exceeding \$50,000, but not exceeding \$100,000 \$250.00
