## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 35 of the *Barbados Constitution (Amendment) Act*, 1974, (Act 1974–34), it is provided that the said Act shall come into operation on such day as the Governor-General may appoint by proclamation:

**AND WHEREAS** the said Act, except certain provisions, came into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February, 1975:

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient that the remainder of the said Act shall come into operation on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2017:

**NOW THEREFORE** by virtue of the power and authority in me vested, I do hereby appoint the  $16^{th}$  day of October, 2017 as the day on which sections 20, 21, 22(a) and (b)(i) and (ii), 23, 24, 25, 27(c)(i), (ii) and (iii) and section 29 relating to section 104(4)(b) of the *Constitution* and sections 32, 33 and 34(a)(i) of the said Act shall come into operation.
