A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 4(a) of the *Visiting Forces Act*, Cap. 118 it is provided that the Governor-General may by proclamation designate any country as a designated state for the purposes of the said Act:

AND WHEREAS by section 4(d) of the said Act it is provided that the Governor-General may by proclamation revoke or amend any designation or declaration made under paragraph (a) or (b) of that section:

NOW THEREFORE by virtue of the power and authority in me vested, I do hereby designate:

- (a) Canada as a designated state for the purposes of this Act, for the period 19th March, 2012 to 30th March, 2012, both these dates inclusive;

- (b) the following countries as designated states for the purposes of the said Act, for the period the 9th June, 2012 to 30th June, 2012, both these dates inclusive:
